CRE8OBJECT PROVIDES AJAX ENABLED WEB APPLICATION

When Brigid Collins Family Support Center required an AJAX based web application using Telerik controls, Cre8Object had the expertise to get the job done.

Brigid Collins Family Support Center is a private, non-profit organization established in 1990 to serve families in Whatcom County. Their mission is to break the cycle of child abuse in Whatcom County. The goals of Brigid Collins are to support the healthy development of all families, to promote family support as a means to prevent child abuse, and to help children and families find services when abuse does occur.

Situation

Brigid Collins envisioned "The WISH Family Journal", a web-based AJAX client data management system being developed with Microsoft products.

Solution

Cre8Object was approached by Brigid Collins to bring their vision to fruition. A high concentration of Telerik AJAX controls were successfully implemented by Cre8Object to achieve AJAX functionality.

Situation

Teamed with Whatcom Family & Community Network, Brigid Collins envisioned "The WISH Family Journal", a web based client data management system being developed with Microsoft technologies. The application would be built as a web based application but it would need to feel like a desktop application. Such requirements would require use of a specific blend of technology.

It was concluded that the application would be built using ASP.NET 2.0 to make it web accessible and AJAX technology would be used to give it the responsive look and feel of a desktop application. To build such an application in a reasonable amount of time they would require the use of Telerik R.A.D. (Rapid Application Development) AJAX controls and the knowledge to deploy them.

Solution

Cre8Object was approached by Brigid Collins to bring their vision to fruition. A high concentration of Telerik AJAX components were successfully implemented by Cre8Object in the "The WISH Family Journal" to achieve the rich and responsive interface demanded by Brigid Collins Family Support Center and the Whatcom Family & Community Network.

Cre8Object worked closely with Brigid Collins Family Support Center and maintained an open line of communication throughout the duration of the engagement. This was important to

ensure that details were accurately implemented and that the project was completed as planned. "The WISH Family Journal" can now be replicated statewide to serve all families involved in community and system based intervention and support programs.

By bringing Cre8Object to develop the management system, the benefits Brigid Collins realized was the enablement of a platform to allow them to provide their services in a more effective manner, through the use of a web-based system as opposed to the current paper and pen system.
